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NOTIFICATION OF ASBESTOS REINSPECTIONS

TO: PARENTS AND STAFF

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In compliance with the U.S. Environment Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), in the fall of 1988 we performed inspections of each of our school buildings for asbestos-containing building materials (ACBM). The inspection findings and asbestos management plans have been on file in each school administrative office since that time.

The EPA requires us to perform reinspections of the asbestos materials every three years. An accredited asbestos inspector has performed these reinspections. In addition, a **DHEC** licensed accredited management planner reviewed the results of the reinspections and recommended actions we should take to safely manage each asbestos material in our buildings.

We have maintained an on-going review of all ACBM in our school during the six-month surveillance inspections. Currently, our Asbestos Management Plans are in good condition, and we will continue to manage our program as recommended by the accredited management planner.

Our schools' Asbestos Management Plans are on file in the each school's administrative office. Everyone is welcome to view them anytime during normal school hours (M-F, 8AM to 4:30 PM).
